

Steps to Apply for University Admission

1 Decide on the profession you'd like to pursue

2 Complete practice exams at school to get comfortable with the format of the Unified State Exam and realize it's not as daunting as it may seem.

3 Select subjects

4 Attend the university's open day

5 Who can apply for budget positions?

- On the terms of a general competition, citizens of four countries (the Republic of Belarus, the Republic of Kazakhstan, the Kyrgyz Republic, the Republic of Tajikistan) on an equal basis with citizens of the Russian Federation
- Within the quota for education (Rossotrudnichestvo)
- Citizens of the Republic of Armenia, the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Republic of Moldova, Turkmenistan, the Republic of Georgia, permanently residing in the territory of the Russian Federation (having a residence permit in the Russian Federation)
- Foreign citizens with the status of a "compatriot"

On an equal basis with citizens of the Russian Federation, the following categories of foreign citizens can apply to the budget on the terms of a general competition:

- Citizens of the Republic of Belarus
- The Republic of Kazakhstan

- Citizens of the Republic of Armenia, the Republic of Uzbekistan, Ukraine, the Republic of Moldova, Turkmenistan, the Republic of Georgia (having a residence permit in the Russian Federation)

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FROM FOREIGN CITIZENS:

1. Passport: Main page, page with registration, and notarized translation (if applicable)
2. Name change documents: If any, with notarized translation into Russian
3. Educational documents: Certificate/diploma, grade attachment, and notarized translation into Russian
4. Education compliance confirmation: Nostrification, Apostille, or Consular legalization (details on agreements: <https://nic.gov.ru/>) (<https://nic.gov.ru/>)
5. Photos: 4 pcs., size 3x4 (color)
6. Visa copy: If applicable for visa-entry citizens
7. Medical certificate (086-y): For specific study areas (e.g., food technology, education, fire safety)
8. SNILS copy: If available
9. Medical insurance policy: For full-time/part-time education, if available
10. Other documents: As required for admission basis
