Welcoming Remarks by Professor James Tang

Secretary-General, University Grants Committee

Hong Kong as an International Hub for Higher Education

Welcome to our Study in Hong Kong Pavilion!

As a dynamic city where East meets West at the heart of Asia, Hong Kong has always been a major destination for students around the world. With over 110 000 students and 5 500 academic staff, our universities are thriving centres of knowledge and innovation, attracting a growing number of young people to study and explore exciting opportunities in Hong Kong. One of our greatest strengths lies in the diversity of our community. Students and staff from around the world choose Hong Kong as their academic home, creating a rich tapestry of cultures, perspectives, and ideas. Indeed, one in four students in our public universities come from outside Hong Kong; and the proportion is even higher for academic staff, with around 70% from diverse backgrounds elsewhere. We pride ourselves as a truly internationalised hub for higher education and look forward to welcoming more talents from around the world who wish to fulfill their aspirations for academic advancement and career development in Hong Kong.

Hong Kong's higher education sector, well funded by public resources, is world-class - five of our universities are ranked among the world's top 100 and six within Asia's top 50. Four of our universities also take up the top 4 spots for the most internationalised universities globally. Many programmes offered by our universities are among the best world-wide. Our commitment to investing in the future of our young people can be demonstrated by the continual increase in public funding for higher education development which currently stands at an impressive HK\$23 billion (around US\$3 billion) in the 2025/26 academic year. This substantial public investment enables our universities to strive for excellence by attracting and retaining top-tier academics, acquiring first rate research facilities, and providing a rich and rewarding educational experience for our students.

Firmly committed to supporting Hong Kong's outstanding universities, the HKSAR Government announced in the 2023 and 2024 Policy Address its vision of developing Hong Kong into an international hub for higher education with major strategic initiatives, such as doubling the enrolment quota for non-local students of UGC-funded taught programmes, expanding scholarships, increasing student hostel places and creating more job opportunities. We firmly believe that these initiatives would elevate Hong Kong's higher education to new heights, attracting even more bright young people to our shores and making it a cradle for our future talents.

World-class Teaching & Learning

We strongly believe that higher education is an investment in our younger generation, and the quality of education is the key to ensuring a bright future. Promoting teaching excellence and quality learning is our top priority, which prepares future readiness for our students through pedagogical innovation, soft skills development and supporting diversified needs with a whole person approach.

Responding to the opportunities and challenges of a changing world, we have launched important initiatives which address the impact of disruptive technologies on teaching and learning such as generative AI, including the establishment of the HK\$100 million (US\$13 million) Fund for Innovative Technology-in-Education. Universities are also encouraged to widen and deepen efforts in internationalisation and engagement with the Mainland with an additional HK\$100 million (US\$13 million) to fund new initiatives on exchange and learning opportunities outside Hong Kong for our local students as well as for welcoming more exchange students from around the world. By immersing themselves in different cultures and academic environments, our students gain a global perspective and develop essential skills needed to thrive in today's interconnected world.

Research Excellence

The tremendous research achievements of Hong Kong's higher education sector are well recognised world-wide. The Research Grants Council under the UGC supports large scale research projects and cutting-edge work through different schemes and in collaboration with other research funding agencies both nationally such as the Natural Science Foundation of China and internationally such as Horizon Europe.

The Research Assessment Exercise 2020 on our eight publicly-funded universities, an internationally driven peer review effort conducted by over 360 international experts, is a testimony of Hong Kong's success in generating new knowledge and cultivating an environment conducive to producing world-class and impactful research. The results announced in May 2021 revealed that approximately 70% of the research projects assessed were judged to be "internationally excellent" or above.

Such outstanding research outcomes have been made possible, in part, due to the substantial investment in research by the HKSAR Government which provided researchers with the resources needed to undertake pioneering investigations and make transformative discoveries.

RGC also supports aspiring and young scholars ranging from PhD students, post-doctoral scholars and young researchers through schemes such as Early Career Scheme, Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme (HKPFS), RGC Junior Research Fellow Scheme, Young Collaborative Research Grant, etc.

In nurturing young research talents, Government has stepped up support for research postgraduates (RPg) for almost one third from some 5 600 to 7 200 in 2024/25 academic year and onwards. Interested students are invited to apply for full scholarships under the HKPFS which was established in 2009 and we receive over 13 000 high quality applications from over 100 countries/regions every year.

Endless Opportunities in Hong Kong

China's 14th Five-Year Plan is also presenting new and promising opportunities for Hong Kong as an international hub in driving national development. At the heart of this vision are eight centres that showcase Hong Kong's unique advantages and global significance, namely financial services and innovation and technology to cultural exchange, trade, shipping, aviation, legal and dispute resolution services, as well as intellectual property

trading. Leading the charge are Hong Kong's world class universities, with innovative new academic programmes developed to seize these burgeoning opportunities. Furthermore, the collective talent, resources, and market potential within the Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area, with a population of over 87 million and a GDP of over 14.5 trillion RMB (US\$2 trillion), create an unparalleled environment for fostering groundbreaking research, transformative learning, and successful entrepreneurship.

We sincerely hope that you enjoy your visit to the Study in Hong Kong Pavilion, and look forward to having your collaboration with our universities in fostering student exchange, academic partnerships and research initiatives that will shape the future.

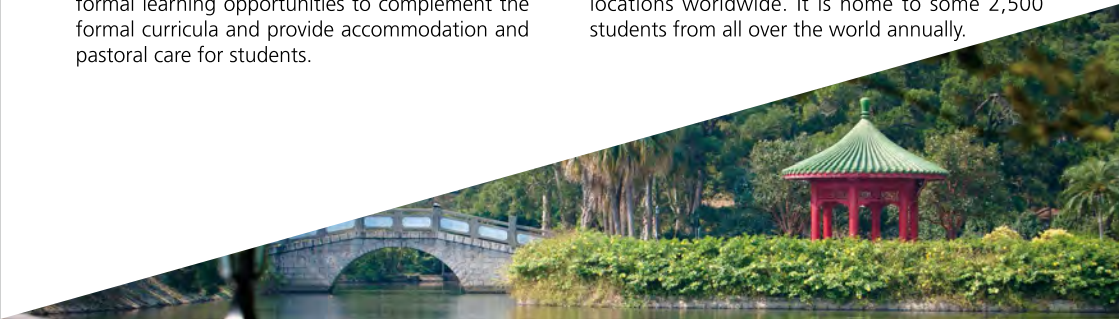
